INFORMATION NOTE

1. BACKGROUND

The World Meteorological Organization (WMO) is organizing a Regional Association (RA) VI Training Workshop (hybrid) on Regional WMO Integrated Global Observing System (WIGOS) Centres functions and tools hosted by the Spanish Meteorological Service (Agencia Estatal de Meteorología, AEMET). The workshop aims to improve the skills of relevant National Focal Points (NFPs) of RA VI Members for efficient use of WIGOS tools as well as a better understanding of the Regional WIGOS Center (RWC) functions, RWC concept in RA VI and Members' roles within operation process of the RWCs.

Meeting of the Expert Team on WIGOS Tools and Regional WIGOS Centres (ET-WTR) (hybrid) will be organized after the workshop on 23-24 November 2023.

2. DATES AND VENUE

The workshop and ET-WTR meeting will be organized in <u>Hotel Bahia Santander</u>, address: Cádiz 22, 39002 Santander, Spain.

3. PARTICIPANTS

The primary target audience of the workshop is the NFPs for WIGOS Data Quality Monitoring System (WDQMS) as well as staff from RWCs candidate Members, one person from each Member in both cases. Other national experts involved in WIGOS related activities, such as NFPs for WIGOS and NFPs for OSCAR/Surface are also invited to attend the workshop, in principle remotely, or as a replacement of the NFP for WDQMS if needed. The ET-WTR meeting is intended for the Members of the Expert Team.

4. LANGUAGE

The working language of the workshop is English.

5. ACCOMMODATION

Participants are invited to make their own hotel reservation. The workshop venue, Hotel Bahia Santander, is recommended by the local organizers. Additional hotels and apartments are available in the surroundings of the venue.

7. VISA REQUIREMENTS

Some countries need an entry visa to enter Spain. Please check your country's Ministry of Foreign Affairs to check your visa requirements for Spain. Please note that Spain is part of the European Union, and under the Schengen Visa rules. For the participants requiring a visa, contact the WMO Secretariat to obtain an individual invitation letter for supporting the visa application.

9. ELECTRICAL CURRENT AND APPLIANCES:

In Spain the power plug sockets are of type F. The standard voltage is 230 V and the frequency is 50 Hz.

10. CURRENCY

Euro is the currency of Spain. Money can be exchanged in banks, hotel reception desks or exchange offices. ATMs are common in Spain and are accessible anytime.

11. LIFE AND HEALTH INSURANCE

Non-staff members of WMO who are authorized to travel at the Organization's expense and/or who are receiving a DSA from WMO must ensure they are fully responsible for expenses incurred in the event of death, illness or injury during official travel and attendance at meetings on behalf of the Organization. WMO liability is limited to the performance of services or attendance at a meeting on behalf of the Organization, is covered by an injury and illness benefit insurance which provides a limited coverage for medical, emergency and supplementary official travel expenses.
